The research team represented our country in two separate sessions titled "TMS in Neuropsychiatric Disorders - Novel Protocols and Applications" and "Neuromodulations Applications and Neurotechnology".

Based on the well-being and welfare levels of societies, Üsküdar University and Kazakhstan N.L. Gumilev Eurasian National University prepared a joint 'Universal Manifesto of Human Values and Rights' and opened it for signature. Even if this manifesto is published in 2024, we declare that preparations have been made and work has been carried out throughout 2023.

The manifesto, which draws attention to what is happening in the Middle East, Central Asia, Africa and most recently in Gaza and has a target of 25 THOUSAND signatures, will be presented to the UN General Assembly and Security Council at the end of this year.

In the 10-article manifesto; “As two universities, we envisioned that universal concepts and ideas should be revised based on the events that have taken place. As N.L. Guliyev National Eurasian University and Üsküdar University, we thought that it is a shame for the university community, which is the environment where human rights and freedoms are experienced and discussed at the highest level, to remain silent in such a situation. We wanted to make our voices heard with an institutional consensus rather than an individual reaction and express our thoughts with a manifesto.” The statements were included.
